

DOC118-V23-1 - Warning to Learners

- 1. You must be on time for all your assessments.
- 2. You must not become involved in any unfair or dishonest practice in any part of the assessment.
- 3. You must not sit an assessment in the name of another Learner;
- 4. You must not have in your possession any unauthorised material or equipment which might give you an unfair advantage.
- 5. Possession of a mobile phone or other unauthorised material is breaking the rules, even if you do not intend to use it, and you will be subject to penalty and possible disqualification.
- 6. You must not talk to, attempt to communicate with or disturb other Learners once you have entered the examination room.
- 7. You must not copy, screen shot or take any type of copy of any exam material
- 8. You must follow the instructions of the invigilator.
- 9. If you are in any doubt speak to the invigilator.

The Warning to Learners must be displayed in a prominent place outside each examination room. This may be a hard copy A3 paper version or an image of the poster projected onto a wall or screen for all learners to see.
