#### Qualification Overview

The purpose of this Level 2 Certificate in Facilities Services is to provide the learner with the skills, knowledge and understanding in facilities management environment. It involves supporting a range of operations including building maintenance, service delivery and site security. The key aspects of any facilities services role include monitoring facilities, developing relationships with colleagues and customers and ensuring healthy and safety is maintained at all times.

#### Qualification Structure

To achieve the Level 2 Certificate in Facilities Services, learners must achieve a minimum of 20 credits. They must complete 2 mandatory components in Group M (7 credits) and achieve 1 components from optional components group O1 to a minimum of 4 credits and a minimum of 9 credits from any 3 optional components in group O2.

At least 20 of the credits must be achieved at Level 2 or above.

#### Progression Opportunities
