Qualification Overview

The Level 2 Diploma in Health and Social Care (Adults) for England provides the learner with the knowledge and understanding and skills relating to the health and social care workforce.

The qualification covers a wide range of areas including equality, diversity and inclusion, duty of care and safeguarding and protection in health and social care. It also contains specific units related to the three pathways that learners may choose from depending on their role; Generic Health and Social Care, Learning Disabilities or Dementia.

Qualification Structure

To achieve the Level 2 Diploma in Health and Social Care (Adults) for England learners must achieve a minimum of 46 credits. 24 credits be gained from the mandatory units and minimum of 22 credits must be gained one of the following pathways BP1 (Generic), CP1 (Dementia) or DP1 (Adults with learning disabilities).
