Qualification Overview

The purpose of this Level 3 Diploma in Clinical Healthcare Support is to provide the learner with the skills, knowledge and understanding in the health workforce. This qualification confirms competence in a range of clinical healthcare support skills.

The Clinical healthcare support staff can work within multiple settings of NHS and private care facilities. The role of clinical support staff is to provide assistance to healthcare professionals in diagnosing, treating and caring for patients. This qualification is aimed at post 16 learners who are employed in a role within this sector.

Qualification Structure

To achieve the Level 3 Diploma in Clinical Healthcare Support learners must achieve a minimum of 65 credits. They must complete 12 mandatory units in Group M (35 credits) and achieve a minimum of 30 credits from Group O optional units. A minimum of 39 credits must be at or above level 3.

Progression Opportunities
