Qualification Overview

The FAQ Level 3 Diploma in Healthcare Support provides learners with the knowledge, understanding and skills required to work as a Senior Healthcare Support Worker.

Senior Healthcare Support Workers help registered practitioners deliver healthcare services to people, which may include babies, infants, children, young people or adults. They carry out a range of clinical and non-clinical healthcare or therapeutic tasks, under the direct or indirect supervision of the registered healthcare practitioner.

Qualification Structure

To achieve the FAQ Level 3 Diploma in Healthcare Support Learners must achieve a minimum of 65 credits to gain this qualification. Learners must achieve 45 credits from the mandatory components and a minimum of 20 credits from the optional components. At least 37 of the credits must be achieved at level 3 or above.

Guidance which details the optional components that can be completed by learners working in each of the six specialisms; Adult nursing, Maternity, Theatre, Mental Health, Children and young people and Allied health profession – therapy, is included before the optional units.
