Qualification Overview

The purpose of the Level 4 Diploma in Adult Care (England) is to equip learners with the knowledge, understanding and skills required to work in a senior role with adults in health and social care settings. The qualification prepares learners to manage complex situations found in Adult Care, and to give advice and guidance to customers and service users of different care services, and is recognised by employers as conferring occupational competence at this level.

Qualification Structure

To achieve the Level 4 Diploma in Adult Care (England) learners must achieve a minimum of 70 credits. Learners must gain 36 credits from the Mandatory Group, a minimum of 6 credits from Optional Group 1 and a minimum of 28 credits from Optional Group 2.

At least 55 credits must be achieved at Level 4 or above.

Progression Opportunities
