The FAQ Level 5 Diploma in Deafblindness for Advanced Practitioners extends the learning from the Level 4 Diploma in Deafblindness for Practitioners and focusses on assessment, service development and service delivery in relation to deafblindness; communication; and movement, mobility and orientation.

Qualification Structure

To achieve the Level 5 Diploma in Deafblindness for Advanced Practitioners, learners must achieve a minimum of 60 credits. They must complete the 4 mandatory units in Group M (60 credits).
